1. Scope

Our Privacy Policy applies to all personal data we collect about you - with your prior consent – for the purposes of dissemination and communication activities associated with EntreCompEdu.

Our privacy policy has been drafted in accordance with applicable data protection legislation (Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of April 27, 2016 on the protection of individuals with regard to the treatment of personal data and the free movement of such data).

3. Data Collected

Data collected for the purposes of Dissemination and Communication from this website will include:

- Website traffic (anonymized)
- Emails for the purpose of content dissemination
- Participants names – with given consent
- Images of participants with consent
- Participation in and organisation of conferences, workshops, networks and seminars

4. Purposes of the Treatment

- 1) Regarding contact and professional data

Your contact and professional details allow us to communicate to you regarding updates on the project, with your prior consent.

2) Regarding photographs

Photographs taken of you during our meetings or events may be used by the EntreCompEdu Community, with your prior consent, to promote the project and content on any media (including the website, social media, ...).

5. Duration of Data Conservation

Your contact and professional data are kept for a period equal to the lifetime of your professional email address.

Your photographs are kept for the duration of the project (until January 2020). At the end of this retention periods, your personal data will be deleted.

6. Protection of Your Data

We guarantee that all technical, organizational and human measures (firewalls, personal passwords, verification system, limited access to files ...) are taken to ensure the protection of your data (especially against loss, abuse, access, unauthorized modification and destruction).

The storage mode and the security and confidentiality measures of your data are specified in a register of processing activities developed and maintained internally.

In the event of a breach of your personal data, we will notify the Data Protection Authority as soon as possible and, if possible, not later than 72 hours after becoming aware of it.

6. The Rights of Data Subjects

Individuals have a number of rights in relation to their personal data. They can require the organisation to:

- rectify inaccurate data;
- stop processing or erase data that is no longer necessary for the purposes of processing;
- stop processing or erase data if the individual's interests override the organisation's legitimate grounds for processing data (where the organisation relies on its legitimate interests as a reason for processing data);
- stop processing or erase data if processing is unlawful; and
- stop processing data for a period if data is inaccurate or if there is a dispute about whether or not the individual's interests override the organisation's legitimate grounds for processing data.
